THE IRRIGATION ACT

THE BRACO (IRRIGATION AREA) ORDER, 1983

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Irrigation Act, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Braco (Irrigation Area) Order, 1983.
2. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an Irrigation Area for the purposes of the Irrigation Act.

SCHEDULE

Braco Irrigation Area

Starting at the mouth of the Rio Bueno and proceeding upstream along the river centre line to a point one thousand feet upstream of the southern face of the Bengal Bridge; thence westerly to the western side of the parochial road from Bengal Bridge to Spicy Hill and Mount Pleasant; thence northerly along the western side of the parochial road from Bengal Bridge to Spicy Hill and Mount Pleasant to the western corner of the intersection of the parochial

road from Bengal Bridge to Spicy Hill and Mount Pleasant with the main road from Discovery Bay to Duncans; thence westerly in a straight line to the eastern corner of the intersection of the main road from Discovery Bay to Duncans with the parochial road from Braco to Prospect; thence north-westerly in a straight line to the coastline; thence easterly along the coastline to the mouth of the Rio Bueno.
