**THE IRRIGATION ACT**

**THE SEVEN RIVERS (IRRIGATION AREA) ORDER, 2002**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Irrigation Act and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order, is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Seven Rivers (Irrigation Area) Order, 2002.
2. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an irrigation area for the purposes of the Irrigation Act—

**SCHEDULE**

(Paragraph 2)

*Seven Rivers Irrigation Area*

Commencing at the junction of Secondary Highway B6 and Secondary Highway B7 at Montpelier; proceeding down Secondary Highway B6 on to Seven Rivers, continuing at the turn at Seven Rivers along Secondary Highway B6 on towards hazelymph and also on to road by the bridge at Great River; following the Great River

---

along the southern boundary on to the bridge crossing with Secondary Highway B7; thence continuing in a northerly direction towards Montpelier along secondary highway B7 and back to starting point.

### THE IRRIGATION ACT

#### THE PEDRO PLAINS (BEACON/LITTLE PARK) (IRRIGATION AREA) ORDER, 2002

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Irrigation Act and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order, is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pedro Plains (Beacon/Little Park) (Irrigation Area) Order, 2002.
2. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an irrigation area for the purposes of the Irrigation Act—

#### SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

#### *Pedro Plains (Beacon/ Little Park) Irrigation Area*

With reference to Survey Department Sheet E 13NW (Scale 1:5,000)—commencing at the intersection of Parochial Road No. 26 and East-West gridline <sup>3680</sup><sup>00</sup> which forms the northern boundary; proceeding in an easterly direction to the intersection of East-West gridline <sup>3680</sup><sup>00</sup> and North-South gridline <sup>3000</sup><sup>00</sup>; thence southerly along North-South gridline <sup>3000</sup><sup>00</sup> to the crossing with Parochial Road, No. 4, Pedro Cross; thence along Parochial Road No. 4 in a westerly direction on to intersection with Parochial Road, No. 7 at Treasure Beach Police Station; thence along Parochial Road No. 7 in a northerly direction to intersection with Parochial Road, No. 26 at Beacon; thence generally in a north-westerly direction long Parochial Road No. 26 and back to the starting point.
