THE IRRIGATION ACT

THE YALLAHS (IRRIGATION AREA) ORDER, 1993

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Irrigation Act and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Yallahs (Irrigation Area) Order, 1993.
2. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an irrigation area for the purposes of the Irrigation Act.

SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

Yallahs Irrigation Areas

All that land comprised within the area bounded by a line running as follows:

Starting at the south-western boundary of Cowan's property near the sea in a northerly direction across the Albion main road to London Piece following the foot of the Mountain Range to west Albion including agricultural lots in the Project Land Lease Phase III, then east of the Micro Dam along the western boundary of Spring Garden Project Land Lease property to where Woodburne commences then along roadway to Easington Bridge. All along the right hand side of roadway Easington to Yallahs to where the R.A.D.A. office is located at Norris, then following the foot of the forest reserve on the east to a point parallel to the intersection of Heartease/Yallahs/Poormans Corner roadways. From this point the irrigation area continues along the said mountain range to include Phillipsfield Project Land Lease property, Cherry Gardens, bordering Montpelier housing scheme on the east continuing in a southerly direction across the main road to include Mrs. Tye and Newman properties then in a northerly direction along Parish Council roadway back to the main road in front of the Yallahs Primary School. All along the right side of the main road to the Yallahs fording, then in a southerly direction down stream to where Hauliburton property touches the sea then westerly along the south Albion Project Land Lease property boundary to where it rejoins Cowan's property.
